

# Notice of Arakawa Mountain Bus Service Resumption

Following the announcement of the national government complete cancellation of the emergency declaration, the Arakawa Mountain Bus will resume and run on a reduced schedule from **June 1**.

In order to reduce the risks of contamination from the novel coronavirus, Arakawa Mountain Bus keeps the windows open for exchange of air and regularly disinfect the buses. All bus drivers, of course, wear masks and check their own body temperature. In addition, we must also ask that all passengers to abide by the following.

1. Please make sure to **wear masks**.
2. All passengers are requested to have their **temperature checked** at the Yakusugi Museum bus stop before taking the bus. Passengers with a body temperature of over 37.5 degrees and with common cold symptoms will be refused passage on the bus.
3. Please **fill in your name and contact information** on the back of your ticket with seat assignment, which is exchanged from the Arakawa Mountain Bus Ticket. If you complete it, please **put it in the collection box on the bus**.
4. Please make sure to use the **hand Sanitizers** placed at the bus stop.
5. We set up a limit of passengers up to 20 people. We request that **a single passenger takes a two-passenger seat** to keep distance from one another.
6. Please keep quiet on the bus.
